Re-opening of Churches for private prayer: The re-opening of our Churches (St. Mary's and St. Peter's) is subject to our two parishes being able to individually make all the necessary preparations for re-opening. These include, cleaning, marking off areas to maintain the 2-meter rule and getting Stewards (volunteers) to be in the Churches when they are opened for the number of hours the parishes can manage in a day. The proposed days and times for the opening of our churches are thus: St Mary's from Tuesday to Saturday – 11:00 to 13:00, 16:00 to 18:00 and Sundays 13:00 to 16:00. St Peter's from Tuesday to Saturday – 11:00 to 12:00 and 16:00 to 17:00. Sundays from 15:00 to 16:00.

We will require two stewards on duty at all times. Thus, the two parishes are asking for those who can volunteer as Stewards for any of the two parishes. Please, ring the rectory if you would want to volunteer. Thanks! – Fr. Anthony.
