Fr Anthony stated that he tries out new things at St Mary's first eg pay machine for donations – if it works out, this will be expanded. Fr said that, during Advent, new Lectionaries will be introduced (4 volumes @ £165) and the Gospel book was also changing (1 @ £250) – parishioners would be welcome to sponsor these and there is a credit page at the front.

Fr Anthony stated that the priests can't do it all, all groups were doing really well – gave thanks for all everyone does.
