ST PETER'S** from **Tuesday to Saturday – 10:00 (Mass)** and **19:00(Mass)** on Thursday.

We will always require two stewards on duty. Thus, the two parishes are still asking for those who can volunteer as Stewards for any of the two parishes to please ring the rectory and let us know if he/she would want to volunteer. Thanks!
