Heritage Grant: We are happy to announce to us that St Mary's and St Peter's have received a grant of £148,598 and £136,882, respectively from Historic England. The grant to St Mary's is for the re-roofing of Sanctuary side chapel and old Sacristy while the grant to St Peter's is for the replacement of tower windows and transept windows of the church. The two parishes are expected to contribute 20% each, of the grant received as the match funding. This is to say that St Mary's will be raising £37,150 and St Peter's £33,346. However, the diocese will provide these match funding to our two parishes as loan. The work when started, is expected to be completed by 31st March 2021. To God be the Glory.
